Founded in 1938, Qua-Ke-Zik Sportsman's Club was originally located on the shores of Dean Lake in northeast Grand Rapids. The club moved to Lowell Township in 1965. In July 2006 the club moved to a new facility on 250 acres near Saranac, Michigan. Our membership includes sportsmen and women from throughout Kent and Ionia counties.
